Overview completions (total 29)

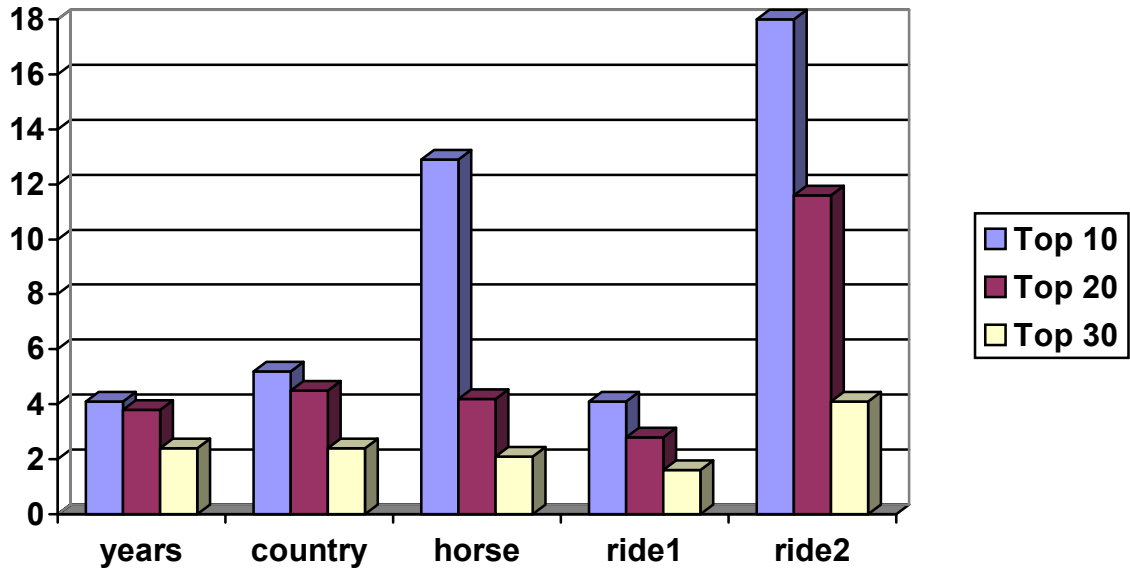


Diagram 2/ Evaluation of Rider's Experience, 1st part, Punchestown:
